They were all filled with a pair of ladies' socks and given to *Chocolate Box* – a Sheffield Organisation who serves vulnerable women in South Yorkshire. It seeks to befriend women and to walk alongside them as they deal with difficulties in their lives. It has been doing this for over ten years.
