A ten-session course helping you explore Paul's Letter to the Romans

Romans in 2025: Following the success of running The Bible Course at GMC in 2023 & 2024, we are delighted to be running a course on Romans in 2025! Produced by The Bible Society, and introduced by Dr Andrew Ollerton, the course will increase your confidence in the gospel and help you to see the relevance of this important letter to daily life.

The Sessions: Over ten interactive sessions, the course combines video teaching, group discussion, personal reflection and daily readings. The ten session themes are Gospel, Sin, Salvation, Peace, Freedom, Hope, Mystery, Devotion, Community & Mission.

Venue: GMC will be running The Romans Course over ten Tuesday evenings in spring 2025 based at the church. Drinks served from 7.15 pm, each evening will start at 7.30 pm, and last 75-90 mins.
