### Help for Ukraine.

We now have a new supply of greetings card produced by the local artist Liz and sold in aid of our Ukrainian Friends. These are priced at £2-50 each or 5 for £10-00. They are on display on a table in the hall.

In time for Christmas 2024, the volunteer group "Helping Our Ukrainian Friends" will make its 19<sup>th</sup> delivery of aid to support those impacted by the war in Ukraine.
